
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What shall be the sign of His coming?



When Jesus ask asked: "what {shall be} the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?", He answered: "When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)" (Mat. 24:3, 15). The key to understand the future is on Daniel's prophecy: "the wise shall understand. And from the time {that} the daily shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, {there shall be} a thousand two hundred and ninety days. Blessed {is} he that waiteth, and cometh to the thousand three hundred and five and thirty days." (Dan. 12:10-12). Bellow is the prophecy's graphic:



After the 1335 days, there will happen the church's gathering, because Jesus said: *“Immediately after the tribulation of those days... they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven... And he shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together His elect”* (Mat. 24:29-31).

What does “abomination that maketh desolation” means?



Idols are considered “abomination” to God. Example: *“Chemosh, the abomination of Moab”* (1 Kings 11:7). The abomination “maketh desolate” when the idolatry is so disgusting to God as to make Him send destructive judgements to refrain the rebellious. It is hard to explain, in a few words, how does it is yet a divine deed of mercy. As a resume, we could say that they restrain the wickedness of the rebellious and hinder them from of to oppres the innocents. It is equivalent of to depose a cruel dictator from a government, relieving the people. In the book of Ezekiel, Bible reveals which is the abomination tha maketh desolation: *“And he brought me into the inner court of the LORD'S house, and, behold, at the door of the temple of the LORD, between the porch and the altar, {were} about five and twenty men, with their backs toward the temple of the LORD, and their faces toward the east; and they worshipped the sun toward the east. Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen {this}, O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with violence, and have returned to provoke Me to anger: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose. Therefore will I also deal in fury: mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: and though they cry in mine ears with a loud voice, {yet} will I not hear them.”* (Ezek. 8:16-18). When religious and political leaders join together in sunday whorship and fill the land with violence, God acts to deliver the suffering ones from their hands.

Though it could not seem at first view, sun whorshiping is more present on christian churches today than many people think. Several symbols used on today's worship service's liturgy are the same of sun worshiping's ancient pagan religions. The very day consecrated to sun worshiping in the past is today venerated in christian world as sacred. The first day of the week's name, sunday means “day of sun”. Note: sunday: sun + day = day of sun..

On Ezekiel's time church leaders, supported by the government,

worshipped the sun and filled the land with violence, persecuting the dissidents. That has brought the desolation. The “abomination that maketh desolation” of our days will be consolidated when this were repeated - churches and government unite themselves to impose sunday as a day or worship, thus persecuting and killing those who disagree. This can only be done through decrees - laws. The apostasy will be worldwide, for Jesus have said that all the world would suffer its consequences: *“For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world”* (Mat. 24:21). Therefore, the conclusion is that there shall be expedited a worldwide decree obligating people to abstain from work and to venerate sunday as a day dedicated to religious services. The act of put in force this law will start the counting of Daniel's prophecy days. The fourth commandment, both on catholic and protestant's Bible says: *“Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day {is} the sabbath of the LORD thy God: {in it} thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that {is} within thy gates: For {in} six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them {is}, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.”* (Exo. 20:8-11). We are not authorized to disobey God in order to honour men's decrees.

Daniel 12 also foresee that God's saints will face a time of trouble such as never was; because a new decree, foretold to happen on the end of 1290 days, shall condem them to death. However, 45 days latter, Jesus will deliver His faithfull ones (Dan. 12:11, 12).

When the counting of the days of Daniel's prophecy begin, the faithfull ones must immediately “flee into the mountains”, to escape. The must not “return back to take their clothes”. We ought to pray since today that our escape don't be “on sabbath day nor in the winter” (Mat. 24:16-18, 20). God promised to protect us in this “hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world” (Rev. 3:10), but only if we obey His instructions.

A second period of time is given in Daniel 12. 75 days after the worldwide sunday's obsrevance decree, the beast of Revelation shall receive the power from all kings of earth and shall carry on a work of global persecution to God's faithfull ones:
